BBQ Cook-Off Teams should be prepared to provide samples to the public. All spaces will be provided based on area required to accommodate your cooking rig and RV/camper if bringing. Please see page 3 of this form.

Cooks should arrive no later than 5pm on Friday in order to have ample time to set up and get checked in. A site check is mandatory of all cooking areas, coolers, meat, and preparation stations under the food and alcohol event permits we have. Hours of the event for the general public will be Saturday, October 27th from noon to 6p.m. It is mandatory at all times that one team member is in your designated area throughout the event. All items must be removed from the Bass Pro site the evening of October 27th concluding the event. Please plan on bringing anything that you will need with you to minimize in and out of gate traffic. When you arrive please plan to check in with the head judge volunteer and complete check-in procedures for your team. Booths will be marked. Please plan on bringing tables, chairs, tents for shade with you; covers are required over food area. These items will not be provided. You will also be responsible to clean up around your booth prior to departure and during event. **Space decoration and artistic presentation is strongly encouraged and prizes awarded!** Ice will be available on site for purchase at \$3.00 a bag. Additional hickory and mesquite wood will also be available for cooking teams that have volunteered to cook the additional meat that we will be selling to the general public for this fundraising event. All cooking will and can **ONLY** begin by the official judge ringing of the bell start. This will precede a **mandatory cooking team meeting at 8p.m. (Friday, Oct 26th) in which all cooking teams must attend.** Turn in time for the judged entry of your meat, chicken, ribs, and/or wild game will be given and will be around noon on Saturday, (exact times of each category will be provided and posted). All merchandising, marketing, or selling of any items or services will have been approved prior to the event, and established in writing between Camp Craig Allen and others, no exceptions.

Event is rain or shine. No refunds.

There will be 45 cooking teams.

Cooking Teams are 1-3 people per team (3 maximum).

Cooking Teams are required to register by printing this form in its entirety, completing, then fax or mail with entry fee no later than *Oct. 1st, 2007 5p.m. deadline!!!!*

Cooking Teams are amateur and not expected to be chefs. **This is a "fun"raiser!** This is NOT an actual BBQ Association sanctioned event, therefore sanctioning rules and points do not apply.

You will be supplied the complete rules in this documentation.

Cooking teams are to arrive at Bass Pro Shop in Grapevine, TX and set up their assigned area NO EARLIER than 10 am on Friday October 26th. You are permitted to arrive throughout the day, but you are responsible for your own personal belongings. You will be given a specific map and designated area location, more than a week before the event, please make sure your information on your registration is complete and accurate.

Actual Check-In of ALL teams on-site is 6pm and no later than 8pm.

Cooking Teams will have a mandatory brief meeting on rules, judges, hospitality tent invitation, *promptly at 8pm on Friday, Oct. 26th. Following this meeting-We will have an official "ringing of the bell" to start all cookers at the same time to begin the cooking!*

Your designated cooking and personal area is yours and security will be provided through out the night in the parking lot, however, a member of your team must be in your site at all times through the event for liability purposes. We encourage you to tastefully decorate and be creative with this space as we will have fun awards given for creativity.

RV, tents, pavilions, campers, smoking rigs and portable smokers are allowed in your designated area. All must be secured and must not be a liability issue. Our Site Judge will have final ruling on a particular item if it is unsuitable for this event.

No open flame grills, open flame pits or open fires of any kind are permitted.

You understand this is a fundraiser event for Camp Craig Allen and our goal is to raise money specifically for this organization. You will be bringing the meat of your choice for the actual judging event contest. The event fee for this \$50.00 and non-refundable.

No sales or services of any kind *not approved prior to and in writing* by Camp Craig Allen are permitted. (Contact Dawn directly regarding marketing and merchandising opportunities PRIOR to this event)

The four separate categories being judged for prizes are the following:

BRISKET...CHICKEN...RIBS...WILD GAME

Each cooking team is REQUIRED by the health department to have a meat cooking thermometer, ice chest and sanitary area.

All teams, volunteers, and participants will be required to follow and maintain ALL of Camp Craig Allen's event permits such as the TABC event permit, City of Grapevine permit, and the Texas Health Dept. temporary permit. All of the rules and regulation will be supplied to each team and will be posted.

In addition, we will have an enormous amount of additional meat that we will need to smoke throughout the night in order to sell on Saturday, to the general public. We are asking cooking teams to cook it along with your contest meat. The quantity to cook will vary depending on the size of your smoker. Additional hickory and mesquite wood will be available.

When we receive your Cooking Team registration form you will receive a confirmation email.

Several communications will be sent to your team before the event, including your assigned area.

Your team may enter as many categories as you choose, and ONE entry per team PER category will be turned into the Judges.

Upon Check-In on Friday, Oct 26th, you will receive the “Judging Packet” of how you will turn in your cooked item for the judging portion of the event. This will including times for each category. We will supply the Styrofoam containers for judging.

All winners will be announced during the event and prizes awarded.
